PRESS STATEMENT

ARTILLERY SHELLING BY TASIS FORCES KILLED AN INJURED MANY IN DILLING, SUDAN

On 6th November 2025, Dilling was targeted by artillery shelling from the Sudan Founding Alliance forces (TASIS). This resulted in the deaths of four civilians and other twelve people were injured including women and children.

On 6th November 2025, the Sudan Founding Alliance forces (TASIS) attacked the city of Dilling with forty-one bombs (in form of artillery shelling) that fell in residential areas. The affected areas were Aqouz, Al-Malikiyah, Al-Radif, and Al-Hilla Al-Jadeeda, Dilling hospital and the market among others. As a result of this attack, four civilians died and twelve others were injured. The following are the names of civilian victims (casualties) obtained by HUDO Centre;

The names of the **dead people** were; Mr. Adam Khamis, Mr. Jabra, Ms. Marwa Al-Haj (Female) and Adam Hassan (11 years old)

The **injured people** included six females and their names are; Ms. Salma Ali Murad, Ms. Enas Suliman Ahmed, Ms. Shalia Toto Kambuka, Ms. Munira Abdalla Khatir, Ms. Safaa Al-Haj Arshin, Ms. Sitt Al-Banat Jamal Al-Hamri, Mr. Abdulmajid Mohamed Ali, Mr. Khamis Hassan Omar, Mr. Ibrahim Mohamed Amin, Mr. Bab Al-Rahma Elias, Mr. Abdulhalim Siddiq, and Mr. Jamal Mirghani Aqrin. Told

An activist from Dilling told HUDO Centre that "according to a military expert, the shelling was from artillery gun (120 mm). This shelling caused widespread terror among Dilling residents"

Dilling is the second largest city in South Kordofan State/Nuba Mountains and it has been sieged for more than two years by RSF and SPLA-N. It is located about 135 km north of Kadogli (the capital city of the state).

HUDO Centre expresses its concern for the safety of civilians in Sudan during this difficult period of fighting between the Sudanese Armed Forces (SAF) and Tasis forces and calls for the following:

- The two warring parties to respect the IHL.
- Tasis forces to stop artillery shelling on areas occupied by civilians.
- Tasis forces to conduct an immediate investigation into the violations and publish the findings.
- Tasis to stop violating the rights of safety for civilians.
