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UPDATE ON

SECURITY AGENCIES ARRESTED TWELVE YOUTHS IN TALODI, SUDAN

On 20th November 2025, the arrested twelve (12) youth in Talodi were transported to Abu-Jibaiha. They were detained at SAF barracks in Abu-Jibaiha and then five of them were transferred to GIS office, afterwards transferred to police, While the rest remained incommunicado at SAF detention.

Between 7th and 11th November 2025, Joint Security Cell (JSC) in co-ordination with the police arrested twelve (12) youth in Talodi. They were held incommunicado at Talodi police office up to 20th November 2025, when they were brought to Abu-Jibaiha under heavy military guards. They have been held at SAF barracks in Abu-Jibaiha, that where they were interrogated by the military intelligence (MI). On 24th November 2025, five of them were transferred to general Intelligence Service (GIS) detention cell and interrogated again.

On 25th and 26th November 2025, the five with GIS were taken to the police and some changes were made to their accusation (on the police file) to be under articles (50, 51 and 26) of Sudan criminal Code 1991 and there is a court session has been announced for 11th December 2025. The names of the five are: Shawgei Elamein Kalool, Eisa Hamad Ahmed, Tariq Abdalla Abu-Faida, Mugadam Abduelrahman, Zuhair Mohammed (correction: Zuhair name was not included in the issued UA, while Goja was included yet confirmed he was released in Talodi shortly after his arrest).

The other seven detainees remained at SAF detention denied any family or lawyers visits.

HUDO Centre is concerned about the safety of civilians in Sudan during this difficult period of fighting between SAF and RSF. The fighting is going on alongside the un-regulated gold mining activities. HUDO Centre calls for the following:

- The JSC/ police in South Kordufan State/ Nuba Mountains to unconditionally release the arrested youth or take them to the courts of law.
- The head of security committee (the governor) in South Kordufan State to investigate the circumstances behind this arrest and make the findings public.
- The JSC to stop targeting civilians.
- Sudan government to respect the rights of civilians.
