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PRESS STATEMENT

RSF BOMBARDED CIVILIAN HOMESTEADS IN DILLING, SUDAN

On 4th September 2026, RSF carried out bombardments on Dilling town. As a result, one of the bombs fell on the house of a civilian that killed him together with his underage daughter.

On 4th September 2026, the Rapid Support Force (RSF) and Sudan People Liberation Army-North (SPLA-N the Elhelo faction) attacked Dilling town with bombs while targeting civilian neighbourhoods. One of the bombs landed on the house of Mr. Hassan Abduelrahman (a civilian) in Alhilla Algadeida neighbourhood, resulted in killing him together with his daughter Omneya (6 years old).

An activist from Dilling informed HUDO Centre that; *"regularly RSF and SPLA-N have been targeting and bombing civilian homesteads and infrastructure like hospitals. Many people died and others have been injured every week". "This forced many people to move out of the town"*.

The victims (deceased) are from Nuba tribes/ Amma. Mr. Hassan Abduelrahman (53 years old) was known by his nickname Hassan Shourba and he was a bicycle-mechanic. Ms. Omneya Hassan (6 years old) was a daughter.

Dilling is the second big city in South Kordufan State/ Nuba Mountains and has been partially or sometimes entirely under siege of RSF and SPLA-N since 2023.

HUDO Centre is concerned about the safety of civilians in Sudan during this difficult period of fighting between SAF and RSF and calls for the following:

- The RSF to respect and stop attacking civilians and their facilities (public infrastructure).
- The RSF to comply with Geneva convention protocols and consider protection of civilians.
